Credits are given for courses of 60/+60 hours in the program *Language and Culture Courses* in Spain.

### Application

It takes place the first school day in Spain, filling out the *form* the student will be given by the Spanish University.

You can apply for credits even if you have not previously applied for them on line.

### Procedure

Filling out the application that you will be given from the Spanish University and giving it back to the Director of the course in Spain.

### Payment

Providing your credit card information, the payment will be cashed by the American University chosen via the Spanish Embassy.

## U.S. UNIVERSITIES

### California State University, San Marcos

60 hours: three credits (\$) \$80 per credit and \$12 application fee.

Master applicants should apply for partial credits every summer.

Credits can be obtained through the *College of Education* or the *Department of World Languages and Hispanic Literature*, once your application has been submitted in Spain.
