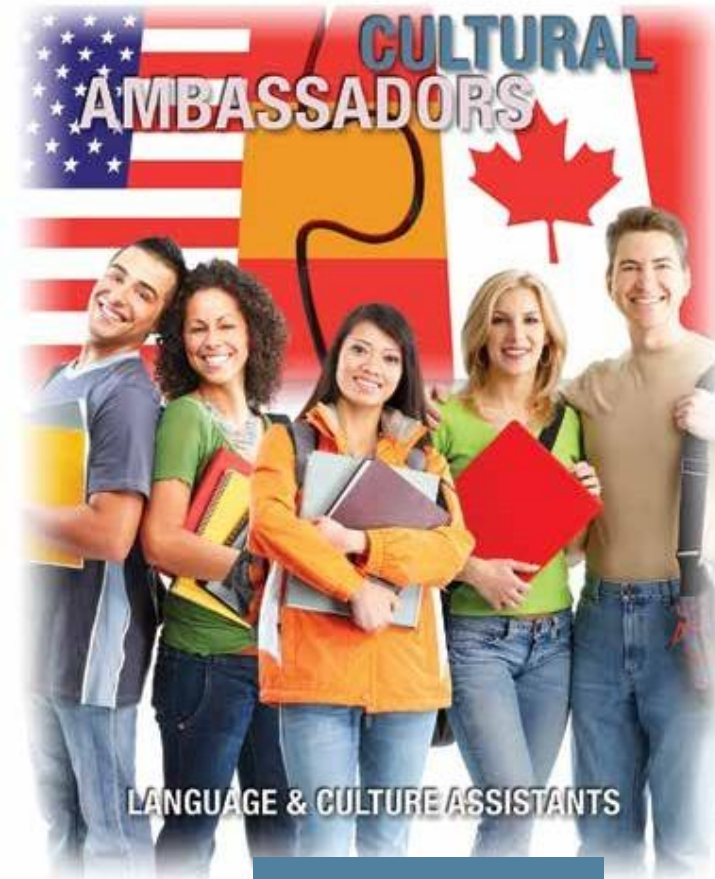

DESCRIPTION

Would you like to spend a school year in Spain? Getting to know its culture and people while improving your Spanish and collaborating with other foreign language teachers in school tasks?

The Language and Culture Assistants program is coordinated by the Spanish Ministry of Education in collaboration with the Spanish Comunidades Autónomas (regions) and the Education Offices of the Embassies of Spain in the United States and Canada. It gives Junior and Senior College students as well as College Graduates an opportunity to visit Spain and become acquainted with the Spanish education system, teachers and students, while sharing with them aspects of their own language and culture.

The assistants will also have the opportunity to learn about Spanish language and culture and use their experience upon their return to the United States, thus helping to develop cultural understanding between the citizens of Spain and the United States.

The program begins in October and ends in May. The academic calendar, however, is subject to the regional education norms.

REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a U.S or Canadian Passport.
- Have English or French (Canada) as your first language.
- Be a Junior or Senior college student or have completed a BA, BS, MA or MS.
- Be in good physical and psychological condition. It will be necessary to submit a complete medical evaluation signed by your doctor when you apply for a visa.
- Have a clean background check.

Having at least a basic level of Spanish is recommended.

ASSISTANTS DUTIES

Assistants will share their Language and Culture in the K-12 system and Foreign Language Schools throughout Spain under the supervision and guidance of the classroom teacher.

They will have a 12-16 hour weekly schedule.

The assistants and the classroom teacher (or the school representatives) may agree upon other activities and responsibilities they should be involved in, such as conducting conversation lessons, attending meetings, making presentations in classes and participating in extra-curricular activities, such as workshops, school trips, student exchanges, music and theater performances or sporting events.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

- A minimum monthly allowance of EUR 700.
- Orientation course at the beginning of the school year and ongoing development.
- Medical insurance.
- Official certificate, issued by the regional education authorities.
- At the end of the program you will receive a certificate of completion for your services that may count as "professional development credits" for your career.

No application fees.

- Copy of the main page of a valid US or Canadian passport.
- An official college transcript or copy of your diploma.
- A signed and dated cover letter
- A signed and dated letter of recommendation.
